One image each from 30 photographers will be chosen to be featured in the exhibit. This is an open call with no submission fees, however, there is a hanging fee for the accepted photographers to help support the exhibit. Please read the guidelines for complete info.

Joni Kabana will serve as Juror for PDX 30

Joni Kabana is a visual artist who is most happy when she is deep into a world which is unfamiliar to her. She can be found at home or in remote villages across the globe working on magazine, NGO, corporate, advertisement and personal projects trying to stretch her beliefs and imagination as far as they will go.

“Show me your vulnerabilities, the places where you lose a bit of control or reflect so deeply that your foundation is shaking a bit. I would love to see some mistakes and how you might not take life too seriously. Send photos where I can see your sense of curiosity and fun, your caution thrown to the wind, and also your celebration of loneliness, afterthought, and regrets: all of our feelings make us stronger characters, even those feelings we fear the most. I will be looking for images that clearly show how the camera was used to soothe, honor and rectify your innermost sensations.” ~ Joni Kabana

Eligibility

You must live in the Portland metro area to be eligible.

We are looking for submissions of work that exhibit your unique vision and creativity.

All Photographic methods and mediums are welcome.

Entry Fee:

There are no submission fees, but there is a \$40 hanging fee if you are accepted into this exhibit

At no additional charge, LightBox will pick up work at Newspace Center for Photography, see below.

Requirement for Submission

Along with the completed entry form, you must email jpegs.

Jpg. files must be titled with last and first name and title (Sample: DoeJoe-Title).

Please submit jpegs with a resolution of at least 1000 pixels long dimension.

Maximum of 5 images are to be submitted.

Deadlines

Deadline for image submissions is midnight Sunday, March 12, 2017.

Deadline for delivery of accepted works is Tuesday, April 4, 2017.

Shipping

Artists will be responsible for shipping to and from the gallery. All accepted works must be shipped prepaid in sturdy reusable packaging. We will retain any packaging used to ship your work to us and use it for the return of any unsold work back to you. Please pack carefully as we cannot be responsible for any damages. No Peanuts Please!

LightBox will pick up work at Newspace Center for Photography between 12pm - 2 pm on Sunday, April 2nd, at no extra charge, and will return work to Newspace between 12pm - 2pm on Sunday, May 21st, an easy way to get your work to and from LightBox.

Work may be dropped off to Michael at Newspace only during these hours!

Newspace will not accept work prior to this day. Please Do not call Newspace!

Return of Artwork

Unsold pieces will be available for pickup by May 16, 2017, and must be picked up at the gallery by May 30, 2017. Artwork that requires shipping will be shipped no later than May 30, 2017.

Size/Matting/Framing

We prefer prints matted, framed and ready to hang with outside long dimension not exceeding 30".

Matting and framing meeting general recognized gallery and museum standards is required.

Please use mats that are acid free and neutral in color. Gallery frames in black wood or metal.

LightBox will offer framing in gallery frames for pieces fully matted in 20 x 24, 16x20 or 11x14 sizes, in order to make participation and shipping easier. LightBox will charge \$10 for installation into frames.

Sales

75% of the proceeds of sales go to the artists. LightBox will retain a 25% commission.

Please price your work accordingly. Payment will be made within 14 days of the close of the exhibit.

Liability

We take great care to ensure the safety of your artwork while in our possession. The gallery will be responsible for loss or damage for the value that the gallery owes the artist for the work if it had sold.

Liability will be limited to the payment that our insurance company pays for such loss.
